Giving Campaign Update!

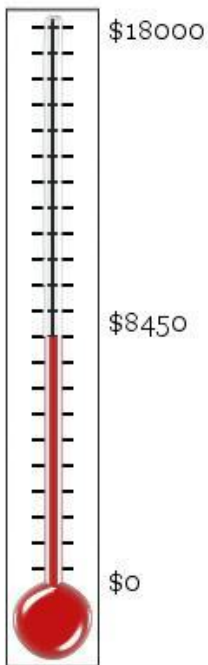
