
Our next planning meeting is scheduled for **Monday, October 6th** at 9:30am at LeBoullanger on Camden Ave. Everyone is welcome to attend!

Music at a Glance



From the last few weeks:

In K-2 we learned basic melodies and movements. We learned to tap the beat while we sing, basic call and response, and every class learned at least 4 new songs. We learned volume control: forte means loud and piano means quiet.

In 3-5 we learned about rhythms and beats. We were able to transcribe (write out) the rhythmic chart of a song by listening and singing it. We wrote with stick notation and learned the names of the notes- tiri-tiri, ti ti, ta, and ti-tiri. The kids all wrote out the rhythm charts on the wipe board together in small groups and every single class was successful in getting the rhythm correct.

At home practice:

3-5 try to turn on the radio to a song you like and see if you can write out the rhythm!

K-2 see if you can teach your mom and dad Lucy Locket or Cut the Cake. Clap your hands together, give yourself a shake!
