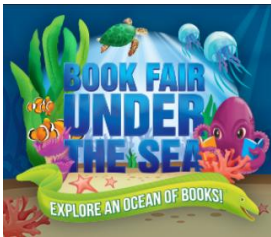

Family Service All Year Long

The beginning of the year is a good time to make personal resolutions, but what about a family resolution? Consider talking with your family about committing to doing a service project every month, being more attentive to your loved ones, or donating some of your clutter to people who could put them to use.

This week, ahead of the Reed Book Fair in February, take some time to sort through your home's bookshelves. For each book on your bookshelf and your child(ren)'s bookshelves ask:

- Have I read this book in the last year? Do I plan to read it in the next year?
- Does this book bring me happiness when I see it on my shelf?
- Can I get this book at the library or online if I want to read it again?
- Has this book served its purpose in my life?
- Would I prefer to keep this book, or get different one at the Book Fair?



Once you have a pile to get rid of, consider donating the books to:

- **Friends and family members:** Sometimes we hold on to books because we want them to lend or give out to others. What's keeping us from doing that now?
- **Reed classrooms or Reed YMCA:** If the books are in good shape and age-appropriate, find out if our school community could benefit from a few new book choices. Consider figuring out ahead of time what the books' reading levels and AR quiz numbers are at ARbookfind.com
- **San Jose Public Libraries*:** Every branch of SJPL has an area near the front door where you can donate used books. The Friends of the Library committees sell these donated used books to make money to purchase new books and magazine subscriptions for the library.
- **Savers*:** Hope Services has a resale shop just down the street from the school and receives books for resale. Proceeds from purchases at Savers gets funneled back into Hope to benefit their clients.
- **Books for Africa*:** If you'd like to combine a service lesson with a geography lesson, you can box up the books and send them to Books for Africa's warehouse in Atlanta.
