




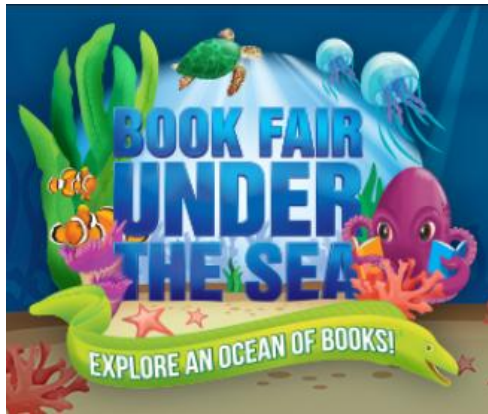

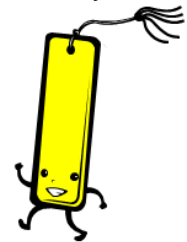

## Family Service All Year Long: Bookmarks

The beginning of the year is a good time to make personal resolutions, but what about a family resolution? Consider talking with your family about committing to doing a service project every month, being more attentive to your loved ones, or donating some of your clutter to people who could put them to use.

In last week's Bobcat, I wrote about how to purge your home's bookshelves and where to donate the books. This week, let's talk about an important book accessory: bookmarks.



You might think that bookmarks are just scraps of paper nearby to help mark your place, but they are also small opportunities to make people smile – they come in all shapes, sizes, and colors!

Earmark time to decorate some bookmarks with your family. How do you do that?

- Cut some cardstock and add adorable stickers, words of encouragement, or stamped designs. If you'd like, punch a hole at the top and add some ribbon or yarn.
- Google "printable bookmarks," print several of the templates, and cut them in strips. Put on some music and color them with your kids.
- Tie a short colorful ribbon to the end of colored paperclips.
- Glue a button to the end of a book-length strip of ribbon, and teach your kids how to sew it on.

While you're working with the kids, talk with them about what they'd like to do with the bookmarks.

--> If you have a set of 30, you can give them to Reed librarian Tish Bailey to hand out.

--> Mail the bookmarks to friends and family members who love to read - no special reason needed!

--> Drop them off at the local branch library, to be used with the Partners in Reading literacy program.

--> Stealthy service: Get approval from a doctor's office or bookstore to randomly leave the bookmarks in magazines or books for future customers to find.
